

Old Westbury Fence / Lamppost / Mailbox Color

The original fence color for Old Westbury can no longer be obtained from McCormick Paints without careful communication with the paint store. Many years ago the card on file listed the correct color for Old Westbury. The title had the designation number "911" and life was simple. Then McCormick assigned "911" in the title for another builder's custom color. This has resulted in many of us coming home with the wrong color.

I have been to both the Tysons and Chantilly McCormick stores, asked them to mix Fairfield 911 and witnessed both stores pull out the "Olympic 911" formula to mix. My recommendation is that you ask the salesperson to mix the following formula. To avoid confusion do not mention "911" in your request!

The correct formula is a tan/taupe tint. (The incorrect color is gray/blue). The base must be latex flat. Oil based mix will look brown by comparison to the standard color.

Standard Old Westbury Fence/Mailbox/Lamppost Color Formula

BASE: 19-502 (Latex Flat)
MIXTURE RATIO: 96/QUART
TINTS

C: 18

I: 12

L: 96

B: 6
